Removal

NOTE: Removal steps in this procedure may contain installation details.

1. **NOTE:** If installing a new module, it is necessary to upload the module configuration information to the scan tool prior to removing the module. This information must be downloaded into the new module after installation.

Using a diagnostic scan tool, begin the <u>PMI</u> process for the <u>HVAC</u> control module following the on-screen instructions.

3. Release the clips and remove the floor console upper <u>RH</u> trim panel.



4. Release the clips and remove the floor console lower \underline{LH} trim panel.
