



New Electric Vehicle Federal Tax Credit Eligibility Form

The Inflation Reduction Act, signed into law August 16, 2022, includes a Clean Vehicle Tax Credit, which allows eligible individuals to claim a federal tax credit for the purchase of eligible NEW electric vehicles. Under IRS rules, dealers are obligated to provide this New Electric Vehicle Federal Tax Credit Eligibility Form to purchasers of eligible electric vehicles **no later than the date of vehicle purchase**. Individuals are urged to consult with their own tax, legal or accounting professional or advisor regarding their eligibility to claim the Clean Vehicle Tax Credit, including whether their modified adjusted gross income is below the applicable thresholds (\$150,000 for a single filing taxpayer, \$225,000 for a head of household, and \$300,000 for a joint filer).

Customers that lease an eligible electric vehicle are not entitled to claim the Clean Vehicle Tax Credit.
